Training Delivery

The Cert IV TESOL will be delivered via Mixed Mode Delivery (work placement required) and completed via distance education using Inspire Education's online student portal. Delivery includes face to face webinars, self-paced study, workplace learning, directed research and online learning and assessment materials and activities.

This online Cert IV TESOL course can be studied from anywhere in Australia, including Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide, and Perth – as well as other cities, remote communities, or anywhere with internet access.

Learners will complete a Personal Learning Plan Evaluation as part of the enrolment process. Upon completing this evaluation, you will be provided with a training plan that identifies your Cohort, taking into account your existing level of relevant knowledge and skills. The amount of training and support required for each learner will vary on these 3 Cohorts:

Beginner (Full Study Model) – Limited relevant knowledge or skill in the competence contained in this qualification. No recent related industry experience. Study hours is up to 700 hours

Intermediate (Partial Study Model) – Moderate prior knowledge and skill in the competence contained in this qualification with limited recent related industry experience. Study hours is up to 480 hours

Expert (Assessment only) – Current industry experience or extensive relevant knowledge and skill. These candidates are recommended to undertake a full recognition pathway. Study hours is up to 480 hours

To successfully complete this online TESOL course, students will need to initiate contact with an approved education institution to complete workplace-based experience and solidify practical skills relevant to the qualification.

Students are required to do six (6) hours of supervised practical teaching under a qualified supervisor at an English Academy or a school with language learners.

The student is responsible for ensuring they have all the requirements for their chosen work placement facility prior to undertaking supervised practical teaching.

Training Resources

To support you in your studies, Inspire will provide:

- Access to a student account in the Learning Management System (LMS) for submissions

To complete your studies, you will need to have access to:

- A computer with:
 - o Internet access through Google Chrome
 - MS Word, MS PowerPoint or equivalent applications
 - o Adobe Acrobat Reader
- At least eight (8) adult learners
- An observer qualified with TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (or its successor) OR a video-recording equipment (mobile phone, camera, or similar)
- At least four (4) ESL learners to conduct practice tests with and provide feedback to

Students will also need to arrange and do six (6) hours of supervised practical teaching at an English Academy or a school with language learners to complete this course. The school must provide access to:

- A mentor-teacher who holds a TESOL qualification or a higher ESL degree AND TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment
- o At least eight (8) adult ESL learners
- o At least eight (8) Children ESL learners
- o Assessment/Testing Tools of the Organisation
- o Equipment and Technology used in teaching/assessing
- One (1) teacher to observe and provide two-way feedback

Entry Requirements

This course is open to both senior high school students (specifically Years 11 and 12) and mature learners.

All learners require the ability to read, write, and speak in English fluently and accurately

- For native English speakers, these abilities are checked via a thorough oral communication evaluation, as included in the LLN Evaluation
- For non-native speakers, they will need to have an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of at least 6.5 (Competent user) or equivalent grading.

It is recommended that students:

- Are 18 years or older
- Have sound language and literacy skills (at least Year 10 English, or equivalent)
- Have basic computer skills

Students are also required to:

- Obtain a Unique Student Identifier (USI)
- Provide a valid ID with his/her picture and signature
- Undertake a Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Evaluation
- Undertake a Personal Learning Plan Evaluation before accessing the course materials and commencing studies

All students considering a self-paced online course should give considerations to the following prior to enrolment:

- Ability to access any required technologies
- Information technology skills in accessing and using online programs
- Experience and self-motivation to learn on their own
- Competing pressures, such as work and family commitments, that may impact self-paced study time

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Qualification Pathways

The Certificate IV in TESOL will assist in gaining employment as an ESOL teacher or tutor in Australia and overseas. However, to teach in Australia, additional professional teaching qualifications and experience may be required.

To teach under NEAS, a trainer will need to hold the Certificate IV in TESOL plus a full 3-year Degree as a minimum. Students currently enrolled in this course should consider enrolling in other courses to support any specialisations.

Once enrolled in this course you may also consider additional training to complement your English Teaching skills:

- TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (this is a requirement for anyone wishing to teach in TAFE)
- CHC30121Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care - for students interested in specialising in childcare training
- CHC30221 Certificate III in Education Support ideal for Students interested in providing educational support services in schools

Students are also able to further their studies in the area of TESOL by studying for the 10688NAT Diploma of TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages).
